Roger and Carolyn,

Allow me to provide you with some good news. Your request to waive tournament deposits for PMGA or PLGC events is approved. Please ensure we work together to finalize numbers as soon as possible for these events. As you know, we need to maximize our tee sheet and protect our F&B expenses as much as possible. It is a pleasure to work with you all and I'm sure we will have a banner 2012 year. Please come in and sign your tournament reservation forms this week with Brianna and Ron to finalize your annual events.

I would also like to provide you with the same good news I gave the PLGC today. Starting this Thursday, MMGC will not charge PLGC and PMGA members the single rider fee as long as there are only two (2) carts per group. This applies to **only your respective association days (Wednesday and Thursday)**. In other words, if a group only has three golfers, the third player will not have to pay a single rider fee unless they specifically request to ride alone. If there are 3 golf carts per group, someone will have to pay the single rider \$18 cart fee. We will continue the special of \$35 for military affiliates and \$40 for Civilians (Midweek Mayhem) till March. Hopefully this special will encourage you to gain more players on your respective days. Please spread the word.
